

Healthy Within Inc is a private psychology practice located in San Diego, CA that serves children, teens, adults, and older adults. Neurofeedback is utilized for a wide variety of clinical and peak performance populations, including TBI, anxiety disorders, depressive disorders, ADHD, ASD, sleep disorders, eating disorders, chronic pain, fibromyalgia, sports performance, and more. In the position of neurofeedback clinician, preference will be given to a licensed mental health provider (LCSW, LPC, or LCPC) who is also BCIA certified in neurofeedback (BCN). The position will be responsible to assess patient symptoms and treatment needs, create treatment plans and review patient progress, and manage overall treatment using neurofeedback modalities. Key areas of expertise for this position are assessment, diagnosis and clinical interview skills, ability to work with computers and technology, and excellent people skills.

HRV biofeedback (or BCB certification) experience is preferred but not required. The position is also required to engage in professional development of neurofeedback skills and knowledge base on a regular basis, consistent with the nature of rapid change and expansion occurring in the field.

In addition to working effectively with the team, this person is hired and must be competent to: develop and maintain technical neurofeedback training skills, including patient preparation, signal acquisition, protocol monitoring, file record-keeping and clean-up regimens. The NFB Clinician must be able to run NFB training and QEEG acquisition sessions proficiently, as needed.

Responsibilities:

- Develop and maintain a high degree of expertise in training and assessment software, in particular Cygnet ILF, HPN direct neurofeedback, and Neuroguide, Loreta-Z QEEG.
- Read, evaluate and interpret QEEG's, review data with patients, and present treatment recommendations.
- Be familiar with databases for QEEG interpretation.
- Conduct assessments, diagnostic interviews and progress reviews that result in symptom differentiation and the formulation and/or adaptation of personalized treatment plans.
- Provide effective case management for patients' overall treatment planning.
- In consultation with other clinicians, make recommendations on treatment modalities and/or referrals.
- Complete and maintain all EMRs, files, records in a timely and accurate manner.
- Must be able to establish rapport with patients while keeping task oriented.
- Be available, as necessary, to provide administrative support for Healthy Within file maintenance, promotional, phone call, and scheduling needs.
- Verifies regularly that EEG equipment and caps are cleaned and functioning properly
- Tracks supplies necessary for delivering neurofeedback therapy (e.g., electrode gel etc.)
- Engage in efforts to maintain Healthy Within at a high level of cleanliness.
- Maintains patient confidentiality, follows HIPAA, and ethical laws and standards

Preferred experience:

- Neurofeedback and Q's: 7 years. BCIA certified.
- Master's degree/licensed mental health professional (LCPC, LPC, or LCSW) or other medical training (RN)

Physical requirements:

- Must be able to sit for extended period of times.
- Must be able to stand for 15 minutes to position the EEG cap on the patient's head.
- Quick motor skills to attach sensors and caps in timely manner and catch on quickly to "hands-on" type of procedures.
