Dr. Tate has been board certified in Neurofeedback since 2006 and teaches the BCIA Certification course. While experience in Neurofeedback is preferred, Dr. Tate is able to provide thorough training in all job tasks for the right candidate. Dr. Tate is a BCIA mentor as well as an LPC supervisor in the state of Colorado, so time on the job can count toward both BCN certification and LPC licensure hours.

TRS provides Neurofeedback services for children and adults of all ages and we are steadily growing. We currently have 4 Neurofeedback training areas and we collaborate with other therapists in our office space including an LCSW who specializes in attachment and developmental trauma and a psychologist who specializes in pain. All treatment starts with a qEEG assessment and examination of raw EEG to develop a unique treatment plan for each client. - Perform qEEG assessments – EEG collection only.
- Run Neurofeedback sessions using protocols developed by Dr. Tate.
- Keep Neurofeedback areas clean and orderly.
- Safely and carefully cleaning electro caps and electrodes as instructed.
- Keep detailed records of Neurofeedback sessions as instructed.
- Collect payments and schedule client sessions using Google calendar when needed.
- Complete SOAP notes for insurance and scan them at the end of each day.
- Enter insurance information into software systems for all sessions.
- Communicate and collaborate throughout the day with Dr. Tate and other team members.
- Providing counseling as needed.
- We have a cleaning staff that comes weekly but technicians help out with small tasks like loading and unloading the dishwasher and putting water in the coffee machine.
